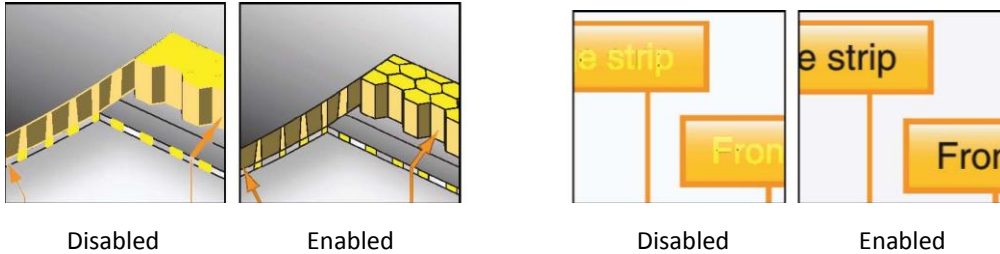


OVERPRINT PREVIEW



When viewing soft proof PDF files in Acrobat Professional or Acrobat Reader, you must have your Overprint Preview enabled in order for the proof to view accurately. Here are a couple of examples of what your proof may look like with Overprint Preview enabled vs. disabled:



To turn on Overprint Preview, follow these instructions:

Acrobat Professional 8 or earlier:

Go to the *Advanced Menu*, choose *Print Production > Overprint Preview*.
(It will have a check next to it when it is enabled.)



Acrobat Reader 8 or earlier:

Go to the *Edit Menu*, choose *Preferences*.
In the *Page Display* category, make sure *Overprint Preview* is checked.

Acrobat Professional or Acrobat Reader 9 or later:

Go to the *Acrobat Menu*, choose *Preferences*. In the *Page Display* category, change the *Use Overprint Preview* to *Always*.
